CITY OF GEORGETOWN ORDINANCE NO. 19-002

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER AND AMENDING SECTION 2-111 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADD THE POSITION OF CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER IN GENERAL GOVERNMENT AND TO ADD ONE POSITION OF POLICE OFFICER.

SUMMARY

- 1. Amends section 2-111(c) of the Code of Ordinances, which sets forth the classifications, associated pay grades and authorized positions for each department, to add the position of Chief Administrative Officer, Grade 12 within the General Administration department and to add one (1) position of Police Officer II to the Police Department. Establishes new pay ranges for Grades 4 through 11 and adds a pay range for Grade 12.
- 2. Creates the position of Chief Administrative Officer and defines the duties and minimum qualifications of the office.
- 3. Provides for repeal of inconsistent ordinances, severability of provisions and an effective date upon passage and publication.

Article IV of the Code of Ordinances, Section 2-111, entitled "Personnel and Pay Classification Plan," is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 2-111. Personnel and pay classification plan.

- (a) The purpose of this section is to comply with the requirements of KRS 83A.070(4), providing that each city shall fix the compensation of city employees in accordance with a personnel and pay classification plan which plan shall be adopted by ordinance.
- (b) There is hereby adopted by reference, "personnel policies and procedures," such document being on file in the clerk-treasurer's

- office, made a part hereof, incorporated herein by reference, and marked "Exhibit A" for purposes of identification.
- (c) Those positions of employment as are set forth in "Exhibit B" on file in the clerk-treasurer's office, made a part hereof, and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby established as authorized positions of employment, and the system of classification as set forth in the document is hereby adopted.

SECTION THREE

A new Section of Georgetown Code of Ordinances Chapter 2 Article III is created to read as follows:

Chief Administrative Officer

- (a) The appointed office of Chief Administrative Officer is hereby created, pursuant to KRS 83A.090. The holder of this position shall exercise those duties set forth in KRS 83A.090 and any additional duties assigned to him or her by the Mayor.
- (b) The Chief Administrative Officer shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of City Council. The Officer shall not enter upon the duties of the office until he has been administered the oath of office. The Officer shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.
- (c) The minimum requirements for the position of Chief Administrative Officer shall be a Bachelor's Degree with a major in public administration, business administration, or a related field or a Juris Doctor (Master's Degree or Juris Doctor preferred), and must have considerable, progressively responsible experience in municipal affairs.

SECTION FOUR

Any and all existing ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed.

SECTION FIVE

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such infirmities shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION SIX

This ordina	ance shall take	effect after it	s passage and	publication	according to law.
