NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

The City of Georgetown has received a Community Development Block Grant for housing rehabilitation or demolition and reconstruction of approximately eight houses located at scattered sites within the Boston Target Area of the City of Georgetown. The City of Georgetown, under its Section 3 Plan, anticipates using local contractors and suppliers to the greatest extent feasible.

All contractors and suppliers interested in participating in this program should prepare a "Contractor's Application" form to be included on the bidder's notification list. Forms should be completed and returned to the City of Georgetown, or Kriss Lowry & Associates, Inc. by June 30, 2020.

Attention of contractors is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed including Title VI, Section 109, Age Discrimination Act Section 504, Conflict of Interest, Section 3, Executive Orders 11063 and 11246, the Clean Air Act, the Federal Water Pollution Contract Act and EPA regulations 40 CFR Part 15. All housing contractors are required to have Workers Compensation and a minimum of \$500,000 in liability insurance. Small, minority and women owned businesses are encouraged to participate. No person shall be excluded from participation in, denied benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination in the implementation of this program on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, familial status, age, religion or disability.
