

ORDINANCE # 15-002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 2014, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

The annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015, adopted on June 23, 2014, by Ordinance 14-013, and amended on December 8, 2014, by Ordinance 14-023, is amended as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION TWO

Except as provided in the Georgetown Purchasing Policy adopted in Municipal Order 11-028, the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into any contracts or agreements necessary to fulfill the operation of City government within the allocations listed in this ordinance.

SECTION THREE

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such infirmities shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION FOUR

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE

This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication according to law.



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCE FOR FISCAL
YEAR JULY 1, 2014 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015**

SUMMARY

GENERAL FUND

Increase Alcohol Fine Revenues \$17,450. Increase Penalty/Interest Revenues \$15,000. Increase Property Tax Revenues \$20,000. Increase Community Services Expenditures \$1,469.49. Increase Transfers to Environmental Services Fund \$25,000. Increase General Government Expenditures \$23,500.

ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES FUND

Increase Prior Year Revenues \$251,348. Increase Capital Expenditures \$251,348. Increase Transfers from General Fund \$25,000. Increase Storm water Expenditures \$25,000.

GRANT FUND

Increase Local Grant Revenues \$3,200. Increase Fire Department Expenditures \$3,200.

CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND

Increase Miscellaneous Income \$24,000. Increase Road Construction & Improvements Expenditures by \$24,000.




