## CITY OF GEORGETOWN ORDINANCE NO. 12-017

# AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATIONS, ASSOCIATED PAY GRADES AND AUTHORIZED POSITIONS, AND AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCES, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 2-111

WHEREAS, the City is operating with several employee positions which have been created at various times but not set forth in a single ordinance;

WHEREAS, Code of Ordinances, Article IV, Section 2-111, entitled "Personnel and pay classification plan," provides that the pay classifications and pay grades are incorporated by reference;

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 12-013, the City modified the current pay grades; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to adopt a single ordinance to create and ratify all employee positions, including the current positions, necessary for the conduct of City business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, as follows:

## **SECTION ONE**

The following employee classifications, associated pay grades and authorized positions are established:

## **SECTION TWO**

Code of Ordinances, Article IV, Section 2-111, entitled "Personnel and pay classification plan" is amended as follows:

## Sec. 2-111. Personnel and pay classification plan.

(a) The purpose of this section is to comply with the requirements of KRS

83A.070(4), providing that each city shall fix the compensation of city employees in accordance with a personnel and pay classification plan which plan shall be adopted by ordinance.

- (b) There is hereby adopted by reference, "personnel policies and procedures," such document being on file in the clerk-treasurer's office, made a part hereof, incorporated herein by reference, and marked "Exhibit A" for purposes of identification.
- (c) Those positions of employment as are set forth in "Exhibit B" on file in the clerk-treasurer's office, made a part hereof, and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby established as authorized positions of employment, and the system of classification as set forth in the document is hereby adopted.
- (d) The compensation of all city employees is hereby fixed in accordance with the "schedule of compensation," which schedule is on file in the clerk-treasurer's office, made a part hereof, incorporated herein by reference, and marked "Exhibit C" for the purpose of identification.

### **SECTION THREE**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such infirmities shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

#### **SECTION FOUR**

Any and all existing ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed.

#### **SECTION FIVE**

This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication according to law.
