ORDINANCE NO. 2022-23

AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO THE MANUFACTURING AND TRAFFICKING IN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF SUCH ACTIVITIES.

SUMMARY

1. Amends Section 4-99(k) to establish consistency with 2022 Kentucky House Bill 252, which provides age requirements for employees selling and serving alcoholic beverages and exceptions thereto, specifically lowering the minimum server age to 18 and excluding persons under the age of 20 from bartending.
2. Provides for repeal of inconsistent ordinances, severability of provisions and an effective date upon passage and publication.

ORDINANCE 2022-25

AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO THE MANUFACTURING AND TRAFFICKING IN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF SUCH ACTIVITIES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE

Chapter 4, Article III, Section 4-99, Subsection (k) is amended as follows:

Sec. 4-99. Conditions, prohibitions and restrictions.

(k) No licensee shall knowingly employ in connection with his business any person who:

- (1) Has been convicted of any felony within the last two years;
- (2) Has been twice convicted of any misdemeanor or offense directly or indirectly attributable to the use of intoxicating liquors within the last two years;
- (3) **For the purposes of selling and serving alcoholic beverages, is** ~~[is]~~ under the age of 20 years, **unless the person employed is at least 18 years of age and under the supervision of a person 20 years of age or older** ~~[who will be serving alcoholic beverages or who will be having any contact whatsoever with the sale of alcohol as defined under state statute (exception: licensees may permit employees of age 18 or greater to sell packaged malt beverages at a premises licensed only by a non quota retail malt beverage package license, so long as said employee is under the direct supervision of a person aged 20 years or greater)];~~

a. A person under the age of 20 years of age whose employment is authorized under subsection (k)(3) shall not have duties that include bartending or any activities listed in KRS 529.010(3);

b. A person who is at least 18 years of age whose employment does not include the sale or service of alcoholic beverages may work in the warehouse of a wholesaler or distributor if there is an employee on the premises who is 21 years of age or older;

(4) Within two years prior to the date of his employment, has had any city license under this chapter revoked for cause.

SECTION TWO

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or a portion of this ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such declaration shall not affect the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION THREE

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
