SUMMARY


Pursuant to KRS 83A.070(1), establishes the salary for the elected position of Mayor at \$74,486.00; confirms the annual salary adjustment to be applied in accordance with the Department for Local Government's computation; provides for severability, repeal of inconsistent ordinances, and an effective date upon passage and publication.





**CITY OF GEORGETOWN
ORDINANCE NO. 18 - 009**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PAY RATE FOR THE MAYOR.

SPONSORS: Connie Tackett and David Lusby

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 83A.070(1) the legislative body of each city shall by ordinance fix the compensation of every elected city officer not later than the first Monday in May in the year the officer is elected; and

WHEREAS, the Georgetown City Council desires establish the salary for the elected position of Mayor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE

Effective January 1, 2019, the bi-weekly salary of the Mayor shall be \$ 2864.85 (\$74,486.00 annualized), which salary shall be adjusted annually according to the consumer price index computation promulgated by the Department for Local Government pursuant to KRS 83A.075, with each adjustment retroactive to the first day of the calendar year thereof.

SECTION TWO

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION THREE
